Lindenwood University returned the certification for receipt of these funds from the US Department of Education under the CARES Act on April 11, 2020 and the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA (a)(1) program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. Lindenwood was approved and has made no less than 50% of these funds available for emergency financial grants to students
